Objective: To provide extra tuition for 17 Grade 4 students at Dudley Senanayake Primary School to prepare for the 2025 Scholarship Exam.

Location: Dudley Senanayake Primary School, Isadeen Town, Matara

Program Outline:

- Frequency: 4 hours per week (2 days, 2 hours each)
- Total Hours/Month: 16 hours
- Cost/Month: LKR 20,000
- Total Cost (12 Months): LKR 240,000

Background: We received a request from Mr. D. S. R. Jayasekera, Assistant Principal at Dudley Senanayake Primary School, seeking financial support for extra classes for 17 students preparing for the 2025 Government Scholarship Exam. These students come from low-income families in the 'Hamuge Watte' area, where most parents work as daily wage laborers, unable to afford additional tuition for their children. They have been marginalized by society, mainly due to their poverty. Mr. Jayasekera is making a concerted effort to show that we care for these families by extending a helping hand to reintegrate them into society.

The proposed plan involves a teacher (Ms T P Manomi) conducting sessions for 4 hours per week, spread over 2 days, with 2 hours per session.

Purpose: The purpose of this project is to create an opportunity for these underprivileged students to sit for the Government Scholarship exam, which serves as a crucial stepping stone for their educational future. By providing them with the necessary resources and support, we aim to level the playing field and ensure they have a fair chance to compete with their peers. The ultimate goal is to help them secure placements in reputable schools, where they can receive a higher quality education and access better opportunities for personal and academic growth. This project not only addresses their immediate educational needs but also paves the way for long-term improvement in their living conditions by breaking the cycle of poverty through education.


